- Bring AA meetings into correctional facilities at Middleton Jail, Women In Transition Salisbury and/or The Farm in Lawrence. Requires at least 6 months sobriety, at least 2 years off probation/parole, no open criminal cases, application and background check, mandatory volunteer training. *Call the Corrections Chairperson Kerri at 802-345-3117 if interested.*
- Mail old Grapevine/La Vina magazines directly to Middleton Jail's Library. Magazines must be sent in plastic bags for easy quarantining. *Send your old issues in plastic bags to: Shannon Leate-Varney, Essex County Sheriff's Department, 22 Manning Ave, Middleton, MA 01949, Attn: Library*
- Be a Prerelease Contact through Central Service and help alcoholics being release get to their first AA meeting. Currently there are no people in our district signed up for this. *Call Kenny at Central Service at 617-426-9444 to learn more and sign up.*
